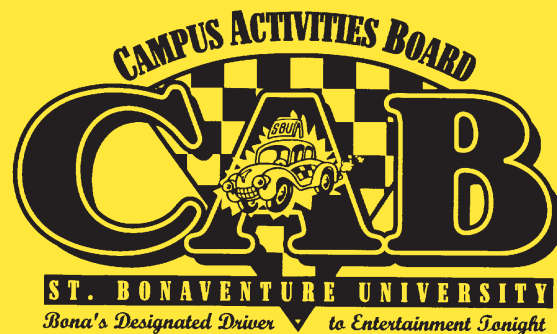

Commencement will be held in the Reilly Center.

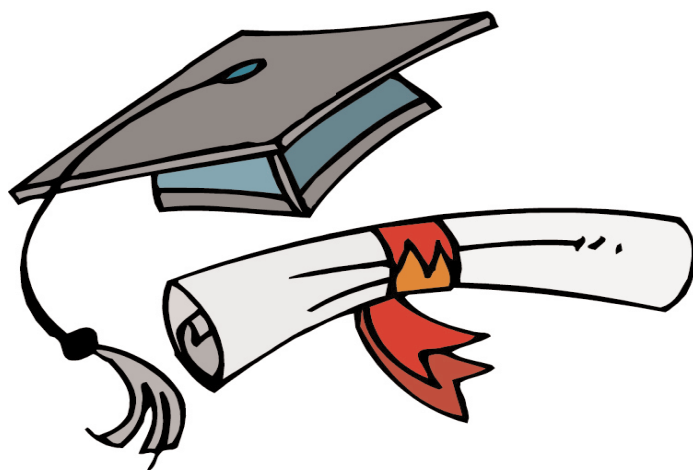
*A Graduate/Family Reception will be held on the Reilly Center lawn immediately following the Commencement Ceremony.
