

Know Ye, That Augustus Wilson of the County of Philadelphia

having been duly appointed by me the said ANDREW G. CURTIN, Second Lieutenant of Company K of the Fifty-eighth Regiment Infantry---Pennsylvania Volunteers, mustered into the service of the United States, for the defence of the General Government, I do Commission him to rank as such from the Thirteenth day of June Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two

He is therefore carefully and diligently to discharge the duty of **Second Lieutenant**, by doing and performing all manner of things thereunto belonging.

This Commission to continue in force, until the same shall be lawfully determined or annulled.

Given under my Hand and the Great Seal of the State, at Harrisburg, this Twenty-seventh day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two and of the Commonwealth the eighty-sixth
