A burying ground for this command has been designated and prepared, where it is required that all interments be made. It is near the Seaboard and Roanoke Railroad, about one half a mile easterly from General Head Quarters.

The ground is pleasantly situated and carefully prepared and fenced. It is enjoined upon all officers and soldiers to show the utmost respect toward this last resting place of their comrades.

A plan of the cemetery is at the Provost Marshal's Office, where it is intended that a record of the interments shall be kept.
