of April in the year of our Lords One  
Thousand Eight Hundred and fifty Seven

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, that  
if the above bound Augustus Wilson  
shall discharge the duties of Justice of the Peace  
in and for the Township of Muncy Creek in  
the said County of Lycoming, and make a  
faithful application of all moneys that shall  
come into his hands as an Officer under his  
Commission of said Office, then this Obligation  
to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force  
and virtue in law
