I hope you are getting anxious
to hear from me again. I prom-
ised to write to you as soon as
I got to the Hospital. so I have
got a good place to write & I will
improve the opportunity. We left
Fredericks Burg Thursday noon & got
& got here Friday morning. We had
a cold dubious time getting here. But
it is a first rate good place. We
have a plenty to eat & a good place
to sleep & lots of leisure in the
after noon the Wards are filled
with galls that come to see the
wounded Soldiers & they bring us
cakes & Puddings & lots of fine
things it is nothing but fun
to get wounded.

What do you Abilismist think
of Burnside now? do you
think this is an other great
Union Victory? it looks like ^{one} ~~one~~
dont it? did your ears hear of
Mc Lelland making such a game
as this last fight was? (No)
I hope they will know enou
gh to give him command now
if they ever mean to end the
war by fighting. I am well
enough satisfied with it I have
got into good Winters quarters by
the means, my wound isnt so
very bad But I think it will
take 2 or 3 months for it to get
perfectly sound there is no
bones broken But the cords are
badly cut I am going to send
for my Discription list to day
so that I can draw my money
then maybe I'll get a furlow
& come home a little while

our poor old Co. C. was lead
by out up I will give you

All at good winter quarters
there was 64 killed & Wounded
out of 100 (that is doing well)
the last I heard of the Regt
they had 84 men there was
some taken prisoners I guess
as do they now Skedaddled

I shant probly get any money
untill the 10 of next month
well I cant think of any thing
more to write this time
