August 6th 1862
Dear Father

our stay in Fort
Cathar Allen has come to an
end. We left there last Sun-
day & come back to Camp Dis-
tinction (as we call it) & we are
expecting now to go to our Post
every day. Last night about 70
of the 94th came here from
~~Gettysburg~~ Gettysburg they were
taken Prisoners there & Paraded
on the field & the Government
want to recognise their Parade &
they are being sent to the field
again they Boys dont like it
very well they think they had
not to be exchanged first

before they fight any more.
Recd Paris Iac Germain Edd
Mures is a mang thour God
Boath was taken But he has you
some. there is a good many from
the Old 105th here. But we are
expecting to go to the Regt every
day perhaps with in a week we
shall go if it is not to day

Will I have no news to write as
I know of I will write again
as soon as I get to the Regt
I can tell that is all the news
I have got this time

write as soon as you get
this (as have made sure)
