Dear Sisters Mat.

I will write you
a few lines to day as I have nothing else
to do to kill time it being Sunday
& there is hardly any thing going
on & it makes Sunday appear to be
the longest day in the week.
We hardly ever have any Sundays
out in the Fleet. Every day is so
near a like that we can not tell
the difference. and it seems odd
enough to get here a many ~~Christian~~
~~christian~~ as when folks pretend
to keep the Sabbath. I have just
been up to the Ward when Great
stays he was laying on his bed
reading a book. I sit down & talked

a salish & then we went up
to the Post office. But not an O. S.
of a letter for either of us. No one
came back. & concluded we would
wait a little & ~~then~~ the folks up
& see if that would do any good
I reckoned the last letter I wrote
to you would ~~stop~~ you up
so, that you would wait a little
longer but I do not know what
it will do not. I have been here
just a week to day & it seems
as though I had been here more
than a month. I am just kinder
sick enough to make time seem
long. the Doctor says I have got
the "Chronic Disease" I don't know
but it is that. But I have not had
the "Disease" but a little. But I
honestly do not think that I
can ever stand it in the field
as I have again. I could stand it

all well enough but long Marches & heavy knapsacks that is
what gets me out. But I
think I shall get over this in a few
days so that I can go back to
the Post again. Then if we should
get in same place where
we would not have to march
but a little I would stand it
as well as any of them. I should
not mind if the Boys were having
some hard marching to do now
& may be fighting. I think they ~~were~~
have a big fight this fall yet. I
wish I was well enough to be
with the Boys now & could stand
the marching. Well I am getting tired
of writing so I will write until
evening & then finish this.
