

New Pamunkey River Va
May 29th 1864

Dear Mother we are once more in
the field and in hearing of Moultrie firing
We crossed the Pamunkey River this morning
at 10 o'clock and we have seen about 3
miles since we crossed the River We shall
probably by to morning morning have a
chance at some of the "jakers" though
we may not We are back in the
same Division ~~of~~ that we used to
belong to, though not in the same
Brigade I dont know what Brigade
we do belong to yet.

I suppose Stanton is here
some where the whole Cavalry Corps
is around here. I dont know as
I shall get a chance to send thru Post

I will visit it and give it to the
Chaplain may be he will get a chance
to send it some time.

Now Mattus dont worry
about me I am all right it is
no more for me to fight the Rebs
than lots of other Boys.

I have not heard from home
yet But I guess my Ma I shall
soon. We are sure that we shall
drive the Rebs. they dont like the
our "Meas" yanks fight this
Summer.

that is all this time
I will take care of my self
the best I can and write a
gain soon
