I expect to be at home a
least the first of June.
I cant write much for
we are all ready to start

I am afraid I shant
get your next letter

"Mete Key" and she said
she would write.

When you write again
direct to the Regt. No
Good Bye. My Darling
wife. I hope I shall
see you before many
months with much love
