This inscribed Colt 1862 Police percussion revolver belonged to bol Patrick Henry Jones. It has a sixhinch barrel of 36 caliber. The backstrap is lightly inscribed "P. H. Jones 154th N. y. V." Sertal number 6998

The gun came out of the famous collection of the late Robert abels of Hopewell Junction, New york. According to the bolt seconds of R. & Wilson this police sevolver was many. in 1862.
