

McClellan, and that part of the Campaign
in Northern Virginia under Major General
Pope, in which my Division, after the
Evacuation of the Peninsula, participated. I was
present for duty and participated in all
the actions, and the several battles in which
my Regiment was engaged until the 8th day
of October 1862, to wit, the Siege of York-
town, Battle of Williamsburgh, Fair Oaks,
Richmond, June 25, Glendale, Malvern
Hill, Bull Run, Chantilly, and the several
Skirmishes incident to such service, inter-
vening.

On the 8th day of October 1862,
I was promoted to the Colonelscy of my
present Regiment, attached to the Eleventh
Army Corps and reported for duty with it.
I was present at the general Engagements
Chancellorsville and Chattanooga. I was
not present at the Battle of Gettysburg
being under Medical Treatment for wounds
received at Chancellorsville, and still on Parole.
This is the only occasion upon which I
have been absent from the field during
