Father & Son

At the head of this page are shown two remarkable pictures of Asa Brainard and his son, Calvin Asa Brainard, both of Buffalo. The first picture was taken in September of 1862, and shows the two as sergeant and private in Company F of the 154th New York Volunteers. Their age were then thirty-nine and sixteen. The second picture was taken in September of 1916, and shows the father and son at ninety-three and seventy years of age, respectively. In the first picture father and son were about the same height—over six feet tall. The second picture shows how age has exacted its toll from the father. He is now almost a foot shorter than the son. Both are members of Bidwell-Wilkeson Post, G. A. R., and their case is the only one known, of father and son, both living, who served through the Civil War in the same company.
