I have finally been able to look for the pictures among my mother's family memorabilia, and I am happy to report that I definitely have something for you. I have a Buffalo Sunday Times spread of two photographs of the father and son, one of which is of them in uniform, and the other of them together in 1919. I also have a relatively large likeness of them together in uniform labeled, GUARANTEED/February 29 1887/Acme Copying Co. The photo in the Buffalo paper appears to better advantage, interestingly. In the large likeness, the buttons, chevrons, trimmings on collars and cuffs, etc. are not well defined and it appears to me to be a likeness commissioned from the original photo — which, by the way, I do not have.
