That I have been a practicing physician for eighteen years,
That I was called to see William H. H. Campbell professionally
July 25-1901. Found him ill with tubular disease of Heart
and Chronic diarrhoea which continued up to the
date of death December 6-1901. Immediate cause of death
was Heart failure; remote cause of death Chronic
diarrhoea and disease of the heart with some extension
extending up to his body.

The heart disease in my opinion being also chronic

William H H Campbell being duly sworn says that he is claimant in application No 274094 Invalid Pension, that he has no knowledge or information as to the records evidence referred to in the accused letter; that deponents disability was of gradual growth that he correctly set forth in his application the history of the same, that he has no changes to make, but that said application is true:

Deponent further says that he was taken prisoner May 2^d 1863. and suffered great hardships and privation in prison and in making forced marches that in 1864 afterwards deponent discovered the indication of what afterwards terminated in varicose vein in his right leg, which has continued and increased until this day; that about 18th of May 1865. deponent received his final discharge from U S Service and about that time he discovered the evidence of what terminated in varicose since in his left leg; that about the same time viz May 1865. he began to suffer from Rheumatism in the Stomach
