Friday, January 1--In our Winter quarters some little snow
Wrote a letter home

Saturday, January 2--Snow all gone but cold nothing to eat
A little hungry about this day

Sunday, January 3--cold-- no Rations to day quite sick

Monday, January 4--some what warmer Half Rations to day

Tuesday, January 5--quite cold more Rations

Wednesday, January 6--Weather good Half Rations very cold
with a prospect of a snow storm

Thursday, January 7--Work all day on ordnance papers--
Snowing

Friday, January 8--about one inch of snow

Saturday, January 9--cold & clear Went down to Kellys ford
Had a long chat with two Rebel officers

Sunday, January 10--continues cold came back from Kelly
ford

Monday, January 11--Sent \$12.00 Home by Doctor Day & a Pipe
& couple of Rings

Tuesday, January 12--Weather fine but cold. Sent a letter
to Ann

Wednesday, January 13--Weather more pleasant Was sick all
night with Diarhea and vomiting

Thursday, January 14--Warmer Recd a letter from Ann & one
from R M Jameson & a paper from P Williams

Friday, January 15--Pleasant sent a letter home and one to
Joel
