CHASE, CHARLES M.—Age, 38 years. Enlisted, August 30, 1862, at Machias, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. I, September 25, 1862; wounded in action, July 1, 1863, at Gettysburg, Pa.; mustered out with company, June 11, 1865, near Bladensburg, Md.

CHASE, JAMES F.—Age, 25 years. Enlisted, August 11, 1862, at Franklinville, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Company D, September 24, 1862; wounded in action, July 1, 1863, at Gettysburg, Pa.; died of wounds, July 20, 1863.

CHASE, ORREN A.—Age, 18 years. Enlisted at Humphrey, to serve one year, and mustered in as private, Co. H, September 20, 1864; mustered out with company, June 11, 1865, near Bladensburg, Md.

CHASE, WALLACE W.—Age, 21 years. Enlisted, July 29, 1862, at Randolph, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. A, September 24, 1862; captured in action, July 1, 1863, at Gettysburg, Pa.; paroled, no date; exchanged in 1864; died, July 2, 1864, at Annapolis, Md.

CHEENEY, HARRISON.—Age, 35 years. Enrolled at Jamestown, to serve three years, and mustered in as captain, Co. D, September 3, 1862; dismissed, December 19, 1863; reinstated, January 30, 1864; mustered in as major, March 2, 1865; mustered out with regiment, June 11, 1865, near Bladensburg, Md.  
Commissioned captain, November 3, 1862, with rank from September 3, 1862, original; major, February 1, 1865, with rank from same date, vice Lewis D. Warner promoted; lieutenant-colonel, not mustered, March 24, 1865, with rank from February 20, 1865, vice L. D. Warner promoted.

CHEENEY, MATTHEW B.—Age, 23 years. Enrolled at Jamestown, to serve three years, and mustered in as captain, Co. G, September 2, 1862; wounded, July 2, 1863, at Gettysburg, Pa.; discharged for disability caused from wounds, July 26, 1864.  
Commissioned captain, November 3, 1862, with rank from September 2, 1862, original.

CHILDS, JOHN M.—Age, 19 years. Enlisted, August 2, 1862, at Leon, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. B, September 24, 1862; wounded in action, May 2, 1863, at Chancellorsville, Va.; mustered out with company, June 11, 1865, near Bladensburg, Md.
