Vols at Great Valley N.Y. on the 15 day of August 1862, to serve three years; he was born in Cortland in the State of New York is Twenty one years of age, 5 feet 9 1/2 inches high, Rufty complexion, gray eyes, black hair, and by occupation when enlisted a Farmer During the last two months said soldier has been unfit for duty 60 days.*
