OATH OF IDENTITY.

and town above mentioned, Min O Dalrymple
who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the
identical Min O Dalrymple who was
a Private in the company commanded by
Captain Devereux A. Johnston in the regiment
154th commanded by Col. Patrick H. Carey
that he enlisted on the 5 day of August 1862
for the term of three years and was discharged
at Manassas Va. on the 11 day
of June 1865 by reason of G. O. War.
