I reced your letter this morning and was very gladd to hear from you and to hear that you was well your letter found me well and taft as a buck I am giting fat I way 159 pounds now well allpred we had a very cold rain hear last sunday it was verry cold that knight the boys run into woods to make a fire to cleape stonke I think we shal stay hear all wint

I gottle in charless letter to tell you to send me sum stamps I wirt you word for I cant git any hear send sum if you can

I hav seen the place
where State Howard was
shot

I was out on picket guard
the other night I heard
some hours running
a fore the fence run right

me think of home
