Dear friend Tip
I received your letter last nite

and orders to be ready to march

worth of stamps and when I git
my pay I will send him a daler
in a letter for I hant got any
stamps nor any money and if
I had a hundred dalers I could not
git any for ther is non to be

had and Charley would be agitting
