Hi Mike:

I received your letter regarding Joseph B. Fay, and can tell you for certain that it is his wartime image in the Portland museum. I know you're not crazy about digital imaging, but the only way I could photograph it at the time was with my SONY digital camera. The museum just happened to be open the day I drove by, and I snapped the image just to have a copy of it. It looks great on my computer screen. Unfortunately, the image, along with everything else in the museum, is being packed up and placed in a vault at the Portland Town Hall, because the Town Board has cut funding for the museum, and it will close in about two weeks. At least we know where the image is. I think it came from the family of Charles O. Furman, since his name is on the back of the card.

Thanks also for the 8x10 glossy of my man, Adrian Fay. I have a copy of that image with a Salamanca backmark. I thought you were going to send me a copy of the wartime image of him with the "94" on his hat. If not, that's OK, I have a laser copy of it. What's neat about that image is that you can roughly pinpoint the date as being after his reenlistment in January or February 1864, and before his capture at Cold Harbor in June. I think it was probably taken at Camp Parole in Annapolis while the 94th was there on garrison duty.

By the way, I purchased a nice framed Soldier's Record of Company F, 154th NY at an auction house in Jamestown last month. Had it reframed and matted and it looks great. I'll bring it to next year's reunion.
