Oak Grove Cemetery, better known as the DeWitt City Cemetery, is located in Section 14 of DeWitt Township of Saline County, Nebraska. The cemetery, about one mile northwest of DeWitt, Nebraska on the north side of Highway 103, was read by Rosella Cline of Fairbury, Nebraska who recorded only the year of birth and death from the tombstones. In June of 1987, Beryl Beerenstrauch of Dewitt, Nebraska added the complete information from the tombstones. Rose Marie Hulse of Exeter, Nebraska recorded the names of burials in alphabetical order in 1989 using the information the two ladies recorded. This makes it easier for use in genealogical research.
