Henry Hill a native of Vermont
was born March 8, 1840 at
Under Hill and moved into this
County Catt. N. Y. when he was 8
years old. He grew to manhood
here among the great hills and
on the beautiful spring morning
June 23-1858. was united in
marriage to Martha J. Lewis a
daughter of Simon R and Martha
(Lyon) Lewis. Mrs Hill was born
March 26-1842 at Anduska Ohio
Two children were given to this union
Agnes A. born July 14-1860
and Mattie L. (Lee) born Nov. 1. 1862
His parents long since been
numbered with the silent warriors
of the cold narrow houses in the
City of the dead. (James D.
and Hannah (Hess.)
leaving his little family
Comrade Hill went forth
to fight for country, god and home
enlisted Aug 11-1862. at T. Hill
N. Y. in Company D. 154. N. Y. V. I. R.

I Brig & Div of the 11. a.c. as

 ville, Gettysburg and the last
 attack on Washington, May 2 1863
 at Chancellorsville he was
 taken prisoner and endured
 the horrors of "Libby" and
 Bull Isle untill June 28 1863.
 was then paroled and sent to
 Connaught Camp. where he
 remained for sometime
 suffering with the inflammation
 of the bowels.

Jan 1864 he received a furlough
 for thirty days and returned
 to his command promptly at
 the end of the term. July 3. 1863.
 while at the Connaught Camp
 he was transferred into Co. D.
 of the 22 V. R. Co. and done duty
 in the field in that capacity
 untill finally discharged July 3
 1865. at Columbus. Ohio.
