DIED - In Golden, August 8, 1891, Hiram Kelly, aged 49 years, 3 months, 16 days.

Deceased was born in Pike, Cattaraugus County, N.Y., December 25, 1841. August 1862 he with 3 brothers enlisted in the U.S. Army and served until the close of the war when he was honorably discharged. In 1866 he married Lucy E. Kidder. One child blessed this union who, with the wife, survive him. He was a great but patient sufferer. During the last 5 months he has found consolation in the christian religion.
