Duane enlisted in Co. A, 154th New York Vols. On July 24, 1862 he was taken prisoner at Gettysburg and on July 2, 1863 he was confined to Belle Island, he was later transferred to a rebel hospital on account of illness. He was later parolled and sent to the Union hospital at Annapolis, where he died.

His remains were sent home for burial. They were interred by the roadside in Steamburg, this probably started the cemetery there. His father later donated pieces of land for the use of a cemetery there.
