I have received your April 8 letter about Captain Henry Martin and the 154th New York Volunteers in the American Civil War.

Enclosed is a copy of Martin's appointment card from the U.S. Military Academy Archives. I also checked for his formal resignation acceptance of April 20, 1854, which was also found in the Archives. The treasurer was instructed to pay cadet Martin \$20.94 which was his account's balance.

Unfortunately, cadet pictures were not taken on a routine basis until the Class of 1857. Only a few earlier cadet photographs were taken and even fewer of the photographs have been saved.
