in the service of the United States, in the War of the Rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was honorably discharged at Bladensburg Md on the 25th day of June 1865. That he is unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of partial ~~of right~~ paralysis of right arm and shoulder caused by gun shot wound received at Gettysburg Pa July 1st 1862.

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief of a permanent character. That he has never applied for pension under application No. That he is a pensioner under Certificate No.

 - (2) A minimum service of ninety days.
 - (3) A mental or physical disability of a permanent character not due to vicious habits. (It need not have originated in the service.)
 - (4) The rates under the act are graded from \$6 to \$12, proportioned to the degree of inability to earn a support, and are not affected by the rank held.
 - (5) A pensioner under prior laws may apply under this one, or a pensioner under this may apply under other laws, but he cannot draw more than one pension for the same period.
