ENLISTED IN RANDOLPH.
Philip Morey, a Veteran, Died Friday at Kennedy.
 Philip Morey died on Friday morning of cancer of the stomach at his home in Kennedy after an illness of several months. He was born in Lafayette, Chondaga County, August 19, 1832, and went to Chautauqua county with his parents when a small boy and settled on Quaker Hill in Carroll township. When a young man he married Mrs. Delitha Chandall Wait, who survives him. He was an old soldier, having enlisted at Randolph in 1862, in the 164th Regiment, Company E, N. Y. V. I. He was in many battles, notably at Chancellorsville and other important engagements. He was honorably discharged from the service September 25, 1865. After his return to his family he purchased a farm south of Clark and lived there until about eight years ago he purchased a home in Kennedy and had resided in that place since.

Mr. Morey was a kind husband and father and a good neighbor. He leaves a wife, one daughter, Mrs. Eva Sheffield, two grandsons, Floyd Sheffield and Flynn Sheffield of Randolph, one grandson, Lafayette Wait of Clark. The funeral was held Monday at 1 o'clock, at the home.
