

George W. Newcomb - Age 28 years. Enlisted August 30, 1862 at Dayton, N.Y. to serve three years; mustered in as Private, CO. K, 154th N.Y. Inf., September 25, 1862; captured in action, July 1, 1863, at Gettysburg, Pa.; died of disease, February 8, 1864 at Belle Isle, Richmond, Va.

Again I will write you a few lines you may think that I am writing to you quite often But Dear Wife it is a great pleasure to me to write to you I am as well as usual to day Our Brigade is going out on reconnoissance to morrow we may have a little brush with the rebs but still I do not much expect we shall We probly shall be gone from camp two or three days Philands resignation has been accepted and he will probly be at home in a few days I did not say anything to N. M. Allen about getting some money of him he let me have one Dollar that Charles Blair sent me Philand say he will let me
