I canot come and see you until after the war closes but that about be over five years according to all of the late reports. you perhaps think I am a strange felow for enlisting but that is all right. I could not stay out there. Jake I shall write a note and let you write one and let Father have the note, you had better date it the first of Sept and let it run one year with us. I am fifth Sergeant and drew my 17 dollars yesterday, write to me and Direct in care of Capt M B Cheney Co G 154 Regt.
