Son of Nathaniel G. and Ann (Westfall) Price, was born Feb. 18, 1833, in Steamburg, Cattarangus Co., N. Y.: he enlisted from that county Aug. 27, 1862, in Co. K, 154th Regt. N. Y. V. I., and served until Dec. 7, 1862, when, at Fairfax, Va., on account of physical disability, he was honorably discharged; he was mostly employed in scouting, skirmishing, and in general guard and garrison daty. Two half brothers of Mr. Price were in Indiana Regts. In Sept. 1862, before going to the front, Mr. Price was granted a week's furlough; he returned to Cattarangus County, where, Sept. 7, 1862, at León, he married C. A. Cunningham, a native of Conewango, N. Y., horn July 24, 1845. Six children have been born to this union: Emma E., Alson H., Minnie J., Marion J., Alta L., and Florence A. Mrs. Price's parents were Joseph and Cynthia (Russell) Cunningham; both of whom have long since passed away. The former was drafted into the British army in the war of 1812, and was three times wounded; but lived to the age of 75, and carried with him to the grave a bullet received in battle. Comrade Price was Constable of Conewango, N. Y. In 1891 he moved to Bear Lake, Warren County, Pa., where he is now engaged in farming, and draws a pension.
