

Fredonia Advertiser, April 22, 1864

At a meeting of Co. "E," 154th Regiment of N.Y. Volunteers, held at Lookout Valley, Tenn., April 4, 1864, the following Preamble and Resolutions were unanimously adopted:--

Whereas, The intelligence has reached us that MILTON J. SLAWSON, one of our members, has been stricken down by disease while a prisoner in the hands of the enemy, therefore,

Resolved, That while we cheerfully submit to the will of Him who holds all human destinies in his hands, we yet greatly deplore the loss of one so true and so noble as the deceased.

Resolved, That in his death we recognize the loss of a warm hearted companion, a zealous patriot and heroic soldier.

Resolved, That a copy of these resolutions be forwarded to the nearest relations of the deceased; and, also to the Fredonia Censor, Fredonia Advertiser and Westfield Republican, with a request for publication.
