St. Char. W. Church 154th N. Y. I. Vol.

I regret the tardiness of getting this thing around
but have done the best the circumstances would
admit of.

The Regiment is now on the way to Savannah
or some other point on the Ocean or Gulf with
Genl Sherman. I left Atlanta Ga on the 6th inst.

The "boys" were then all well, and in fine spirits.
— Col Jones wishes to be remembered to you particularly.
His health was much improved.

I hope to see you sometime during the winter if my
health is sufficient for the trip to Washington. Let me hear
from you.
