camp tylor Baltamore MD on them they will come here and be advertised and  
if you will put 1st Bitalian 3rd Company on them they will be brought to  
my tent it is of no acount to have my Company and Redgement on them unles  
there shuld be another man of the same name here which is not likley  
I have twenty dollers to send you and i am afraid to send it tell i know  
that you get my letters and it is not the safest place in the world to  
cary it in my pocket

We have preaching here sundays at 5 oclock last sunday General Tylor  
attended meting and afteer servee he sent a guard thugh they camp to  
get every man that did not come out he said that he wanted to see how  
men loke who was so lasey that they could not tend meeting once a weeak  
but i must conclude with my love to you and all
