OATH OF IDENTITY.

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the

who was a private in the Company commanded by
Captain Cameron in the Regiment

1840 commanded by Col. Wagner
that he enlisted on the 6th day of September

for the term of 3 months and was discharged
at New York City on the 27th day

of 1865 by reason of being honorably
discharged by the War Dept. July 12th 1865
