

Memorandum Book Miles Tupper

enlisted Aug 10th 1862 in the 154th regiment N.Y.S.V., Co. G
Dec. 10, left the regiment sick at Fairfax C.H.
Dec. 21 was admitted to the Hospital at Fort Schuyler N.Y.
1863 Apr. 2nd left Fort Schuyler went to FortWood Bedloes
Island N.Y.
Apr. 6th left FortWood arrived at Washington next day.
Apr. 8th went to distribution camp near Alexandria, Va.
Apr. 10~~th~~. left camp went to Alexandria stayd till next day.
11th went to Acqua creek on boat arrived at the regiment about
five oclock Pm
12th Sunday
13th marched from camp and encamped near the Rapahanock next day
Apr. 15th began to rain in the night and rained all day.
Apr. 28 crossed the river and encamped near it. Apr 30 we
started early crossed the Rapadam river about two oclock
P.m and encamped about 7 miles from Fredricksburgh about
midnight making a days march of about 20 miles
May 1st fireing was heard nearly al day
May 2nd we were attacked on our right about 6 oclock Pm and
were forced back about one mile.
May 3rd Fighting commenced early I was wounded soon after the
fighting began
May 4th I was carried form that place by the Rebbles to an old
house in the field where they were careing for the wounded
shells were thrown over us several times during the night
May 5th continued raining very cold
May 14 ambulances arrived to take us away
May 15 crossed the river at U.S Ford and was taken to the
Div. Hospt at Brooks Station
May 25 I was sent to Alexandria to Queen Street Hospital
May 27 was transferd to McVeigh Hospt with my Brother Darius
June 17 was sent to Philadelphia Chestnut Hill Hospt arrived
there on the night of the 18th
Aug 5. Started for home on furlough reached home on the 7th
Aug 16 received the ordinance of baptism myself and wife
Sept 8 Started for Hospt arrived there on the evening of the 9th
Feb 11th 1864 received furlough for 30 days arrived at my home
on the 13th inst.
