Taylor Vanderburgh, of Versailles, died Saturday, the 3d inst, aged 84 years. He enlisted in Aug. 1862 in Co. K., 154th N. Y. Vols. He was at that time 59 years old. He served with his company until the close of the war, and was a good soldier. Since his return in 1865 he has worked at his trade of wagon maker, and supported his family. I had a visit with him July 7th of this year at his wagon shop in Versailles, and little thought he would so soon be summoned to the final roll call.
