i am once more seated to write to you to let you know that i am well at present and hope these few lines will find you the same i haint herd from you in a long time i dont know what it means i wish you would write once a weak for i want to here from home often please write and tell me what you are a going to do this summer we haint got no pay yet but when we get it i shall send you forty dollars alak is well and tuff we have got to go out on company drill so i must stop good by till the next from
