Public Relations Society

Arts & Sciences is the largest of the four schools with almost half of Bona's students majoring in at least one of our programs. Moreover, Arts & Sciences faculty teach the vast majority of the courses that comprise the Clare College core curriculum, which is our innovative, interdisciplinary approach to the liberal arts education, and the offerings for the Honors Program, also designed from an interdisciplinary perspective.

The school is diverse, with 15 departments covering the arts and humanities, natural sciences, and social sciences. Additionally, there are a number of inter- and multidisciplinary programs whose home is in A&S, and students hoping to teach at the secondary level major in an A&S discipline. All of our students are required to complete a senior capstone experience in their major, and there are several programs to support students' learning by doing scholarship in their major field of study. One differentiating aspect of Arts & Sciences at Bona's is that we also seek to have these projects provide a service to our community—we view this as the logical academic initiative for a Franciscan institution.

The addition to the campus was celebrated on October 1, 2004



In its early years, the main entrance to campus used to be a metal sign over the roadway near Devereux Hall. The 60-foot steel cross was designed in 1964. On October 1, 2004 the University dedicated two walls on either side of the cross. The left tower bears the seal of the province of the Most Holy Name of Jesus, and the right tower bears the seal of the Province of the Immaculate Conception. Both seals relate to the early history of the university.

The new entrance walls were donated by the class of 1953 in memory of Brother Ferdinand Woerle, O.F.M, a groundskeeper at St. Bonaventure for 60 years. Brother Ferdinand had a respiratory condition, and due to this preferred working outside in the fresh air. A plaque dedicated to his memory is located on the right wall facing the entrance roadway. It reads, "In Gratitude, The Class of 1953 dedicates this entrance in loving memory of Br. Ferdinand Woerle, O.F.M, who for nearly 60 years showed his love for St. Bonaventure University by helping to make this campus a more beautiful and welcome place."
