So, here we give to you, four years of pictures and four years of memories. And these memories are sure to last a lifetime.



Brother Harry Monaco October 14, 1963-December 5, 2011



The death of Fr. Harry Monaco was, and remains, a tragic blow to St. Bonaventure University. Serving as the faculty advisor to the Bonavoyageurs—SBU's outdoors club— which was headed by Tony Zambito and myself, I came to know Harry on a very personal level. Needless to say, his passing dwelled heavily on our hearts.

But in the wake of our collective grief, stories have begun circulating about the incredible life of this humble, thoughtful man. It has been astonishing to me, not because Harry was able to positively affect so many people in all facets of the Bonaventure community, but because he was able to do it in such an unassuming way. Harry was careful with his words and actions, but that which he said and did was always full of deep insight. When he laughed, you could see his childish nature; he was a person who reveled in the splendors of the world around him. A Franciscan in the deepest sense, Harry taught me so much about the truth and beauty that could be found in nature. His passion for new experience was brilliantly matched with his wild heart and his compassionate soul.

In the coming times, some will remember Harry as a light-hearted teacher, some will remember him as an eager pianist, and yet others will remember him as a fervent, young priest. For me, my image of Harry will always remain the same: a man wearing a massive winter coat, bundled from head-to-toe, strapped into this snowshoes and grinning, literally, from ear-to-ear, thrilled that four or five people showed up to go on a hike with him.

A Life Well Lived! Fr. Harry Monaco, OFM October 14, 1963 – December 5, 2012

I've known Harry Monaco for the past 22 years. He was three years ahead of me in "formation." That is the initial time in our Franciscan Friar life where we learn what it means to be a Franciscan Friar: a person of prayer, a person of community and a person of service. During the course of those 22 years we not only became friars and brothers to one another we also became friends. When Harry's spiritual journey lead him away from the friars he continued to explore and deepen the call to be a man of prayer, community and service. By the time Harry's journey lead him back to the friars I, along with a multitude of other friars, was grateful to welcome Harry back to our brotherhood. Although a bit older and much wiser, Harry returned to us and began again as if he had never left.

By the time Harry was to go out on his "Internship," before he could make his Solemn Profession, I as the then Director of Post Novitiate Formation, had to discuss with Harry what he wanted to do, where he wanted to go. We had talked about his future plans and what he had hoped to do as a friar minor. He had always loved St. Bonaventure University, as it was his alma mater and was instrumental part of his life. He always loved returning to campus and especially loved going back to Mt. Irenaeus. He enjoyed the company of the friars and friends amidst the life and beauty that surrounds our Enchanted Mountains. His fond memories of Fr. Dan Riley, OFM and Fr. Dan Hurley, OFM, of when he was a student at Bonas, reminded him of his home, wherever he was living.

Soon after Harry died his cousin Amanda said to me in an email, "Harry was a special person. Not only was he kind, fun and compassionate he had a special gift that allowed him to connect with others so easily."

We all love Harry and our memories of Harry because he was a special person, because he was kind and fun and compassionate and because he connected with us.

Harry grew, not only to be a man of prayer, community and service, he was a man of integrity and honesty, of humble service, and one who strove for excellence in everything he did and he was always filled with gratitude. Harry had a joy that we all long to find.

Not too long ago I went up to the cemetery across the street from the University where Harry, along with our other venerable and distinguished Franciscan brothers and sister now rest, and found a piece of paper, soaked from the day's rain, that read:

Dear Fr. Harry, Thank You for everything. I wish you could have been with us at graduation today. I missed your Gloria at Mass. You taught me not to give up on the Church and Catholicism. For you, I'll try anything. Love you and miss you, Br. Harry."

Harry would be incredibly embarrassed to know that the Class of 2012 has dedicated their yearbook to him. He didn't do well with honors and accolades. He wasn't one who would draw attention to himself. As the Guardian of St. Bonaventure Friary and on behalf of our entire Franciscan community, but also as a friar and a friend, I am grateful that you would honor our brother, Fr. Harry Monoco, OFM, and his life well lived.

Both men and women were scoreboard leaders in there 2011-2012 seasons. Both were defending champions in their NY State leagues and the women finished in the top four for Division III rugby.





In Memory of Dr. John J. Watson



Dr. John J. Watson, 45, professor of marketing in the School of Business at St. Bonaventure University, died unexpectedly Friday, May 18.

His passing was just 13 months after the death of his father, Dr. John G. Watso dean of the School of Business and a beloved member of the St. Bonaventure faculty for 35 years.

"John was such a rising star in our School of Business, much like his dad was 3 years ago," said Sr. Margaret Carney, O.S.F., university president.

A native of Franklinville, N.Y., Dr. John J. Watson graduated from Archbishop Walsh High School in Olean.

He earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from Bucknell University in 1988 and his master's in business administration from Bucknell in 1989. He earned his Ph.D. in marketing in 1996 from Penn State, where he was a graduate assistant in the Department of Marketing.

Watson played basketball at Bucknell and spent two years after college, 1989 to 1991, playing professionally in Ireland and England. He was also a former coach, owner and president of the Canterbury Rams in the New Zealand National Basketball League and was named Coach of the Year in 2002.

Watson was a former assistant and associate professor in the Department of Management at The University of Canterbury, Christchurch, New Zealand, from 1996 to 2008. He was highly involved with students at Canterbury, where he founded the Business and Sport Management Society, chaired the International Student Exchange Committee and served on the university's MBA Board of Directors. He received the Best Teacher Award in 1997 and 2006 as a faculty member in Canterbury's College of Business and Economics.


He first joined the faculty at St. Bonaventure as a visiting professor in the fall of 2004 and became a full-time faculty member in 2008.

"John was highly respected by the faculty, staff, and students in the School of Business," said Dr. Carol Fischer, a longtime colleague and dean of the School of Business at the time of his death. "His energy and enthusiasm were contagious, and his contributions to curriculum and programming are a lasting legacy."

Watson also served as the primary color commentator for SBU-TV broadcasts of men's basketball games.

Watson is survived by his wife, Dr. Leslie Raymore Watson; four children, John, Noah, Stephen and Elizabeth; his mother, Dr. Suzanne Watson, a former lecturer in the Department of Computer Science at St. Bonaventure; a brother, Stephen, athletic director at St. Bonaventure; and a sister, Jane. His sister Christine passed away in 2006.


